



Currently showing: Indonesia > Probabilistic Projections > Pop Ratios > Total Dependency > Age 0-14 plus 65 and over by 15-64






"The arrival of the largest educated cohort of young adults (and the demographic window of opportunity) in Indonesia today coincides with a complex sets of labour market and economic conditions different to those that foregrounded the demographic window of opportunity in places like South Korea in the mid 1970s- mid 1980s."

Premature de-industrialization: "countries are running out of industrialization opportunities sooner and at much lower levels of income compared to the experience of early industrializers....evidence suggests both globalization and labor-saving technological progress in manufacturing – including automation- have been behind these developments. Premature deindustrialization has potentially significant economic and political ramifications, including lower economic growth and democratic failure." (Dani Rodrik, 2015: 1)


Employment by sectors: Agriculture, Industry, Services, 1991 - 2020



Changing nature of work: digital disruption, industry 4.0, gig economy, new economy, Post-Fordist world




Youth unemployment in Indonesia is relatively high despite (Idle youth: 21%)


Therefore, the Government continues to encourage entrepreneurs, especially young entrepreneurs, to grow and develop, the President added.

Entrepreneurship OR creating jobs when there are... none?


"For two years in a row, jobsDB.com held a job fair at Kartika Chandra. Thousands of people came from the break of dawn until late at night. It was like a riot. Some fainted for queuing too long ... To my knowledge, before, people preferred to be employees because they had the power to bargain into their positions.

But now, there are too many university graduates. So apart from the fact that job vacancies are limited, when they do get the chance, they'll get a really small salary. The companies do not want to fork out much money, and the graduates are willing to work at such low pay.


A number of my friends who graduated from their bachelors are only getting paid four to five hundred thousand rupiah per month working on a contract basis at foreign companies! That's their gross wage! That's probably their motivation to open up their own business, so they can make more money.

Everybody wants to get paid a lot but it's not possible. When I graduate, just in that one semester, about two, three thousand people graduated. I was from economics, and there were one thousand and five hundred of us graduating in just one semester. Can you imagine if we gather all the graduates from all over Indonesia? Especially now, you can work outside your field (of study at university)!"




