

 - Risk Assessment,
 - Code of Ethics & Business Conduct
 - Speak-up/whistleblowing channels and follow-up process






- 1. Leveraging existing risk assessments, tools and measures
- 2. Working across the organization reduce silos and share information including to and from subsidiaries
- 3. Synergies, efficiencies and coherent approaches



e.g. ABMS and Responsible Business Conduct



SOE boards should develop, implement, monitor and communicate internal controls, ethics and compliance programmes or measures, including those which contribute to preventing fraud and corruption.

What is an effective ABMS? Is it making a difference?

- 1. Asking employees (surveys), measuring (how and what), monitoring, root cause analyses (use the data from hotline reports and investigations, internal audit reports)
- 2. Actively review and update risks and mitigation measures
- 3. Collaborate with other SOEs to identify indicators of effectiveness.
